## **Prerequisites and special admittance requirements program**

The Degree of Bachelor of Arts including 90 Higher Education Credits (major) in a discipline related to the course (English Literature).

Knowledge of English documented by an international proficiency test (TOEFL test) including TWE with a minimum of 630 (paper) 267 (computer) or 109 (internet) or Cambridge Certificate of Proficiency or IELTS test with a minimum of 7.5 (and no module under 7), or the equivalent. The Stockholm university TOEFL code is SU0008.

## **Program structure**

The programme consists of compulsory course work 75 ECTS credits, optional course/s 15 ECTS credits, and degree project 30 ECTS credits. For information about the compulsory courses see course syllabus for each separate course.

## **Goals**
