## Prerequisites and special admittance requirements

#### Course structure

#### **Course content**

The aim of the course is to give the student knowledge and understanding of Spanish medieval literature, culture and literature. The aim is also to provide a basic competence in Old Spanish and in the history of the Spanish language.

# Learning outcomes

After completing the course student is expected to:

- be able to interpret and understand medieval Spanish texts
- identify and compare key stages in the culture and literature of the Middle Ages in Spain
- clarify on the basis of a specific text those cultural aspects which are characteristic of the Middle Ages, for example, gender-related aspects
- explain certain words in a text from a linguistic point of view.

### **Education**

Teaching is given in the form of lessons, group work and individual instruction. In the event of low student registration instruction will take the form of tutorials or individual tutoring.

#### Forms of examination

a. The course is examined in the following way:

Oral presentations and individually written take-home work.

b. Grades are given according to a goal related criterion referenced seven-point scale:

A = Excellent

B= Very Good

C = Good D = Satisfactory E = Sufficient Fx = Insufficient F = Fail

- c. The grading criteria for this course are to be distributed at the beginning of the course.
- d. A grade of at least E on all modules is required in order to obtain a passing grade for the whole course.

A student, who has received the grade of E or higher, may not re-take the test in order to get a higher grade.

e. In order to obtain at least the grade of E, a student who has received a failing grade of F or Fx has the right to undergo four additional tests provided the course is still offered.

A student, who has received the grade of Fx or F twice on a given test by the same examiner can, on application, be granted a new examiner, unless there are specific reasons against it. The application for reexamination should be addressed to the board of the department.
