Decision

This course plan was approved by the Board of the Department of Human Geography 2008-06-10 and revised 2008-12-15.

Prerequisites and special admittance requirements

150 HECs and a bachelor's thesis, 15 HECs, in Urban and Regional Planning or at the Bachelor's Programme in Urban and Regional Planning or 15 HECs at the Master's Programme in Urban and Regional Planning.

Course content

The course comprises an applied study conducted individually and in contact with an organisation external to the university.

Learning outcomes

Upon completion of course, the student is expected to be able to:

- In cooperation with an organisation external to the university, collect, assemble and analyse data from relevant questions.
- Present the results from the applied study in written and verbal forms.

Education

Teaching takes place in the form of seminars and supervision.

Attendance can be required.

Forms of examination

- The testing of knowledge occurs through the expected development of study results. The examination will take place via written and oral exams.
- Grades are decided according to a seven-grade goal-related scale:

A = Excellent
B = Very good
C = Good
D = Satisfactory
E = Adequate
Fx = Insufficient
F = Deficient

- c. The course's grade criteria will be given out at the beginning of the course.
- d. In order to get a final grade for the entire course, the student must get at least an E on each of the course sections.
- e. In the case of failure, students have the right to one additional project on assignment, in order to reach at least an E. However, not more than two projects in all.
- f. Students who received an Fx or F on an exam/test twice from the same examiner have the right to have another examiner decide their grade, barring any particular reasons for exclusion. A petition for this request must be made to the institutional board.

Interim

If the course is no longer offered, or if the course content has been significantly changed, the student has the right to be examined according to their course plan three times up to a three-term period. However, the limitations outlined in Testing of Knowledge and Examination, as described above, still apply.

Limitations

The course cannot be taken as part of the degree requirements together with the courses Project on Assignment in Human Geography 15 ECTS credits (KG4203), Project on Assignment in Urban and Regional Planning 15 ECTS credits (KG4204), Project on Assignment in Human Geography 15 ECTS credits (KG4207), Project on Assignment in Human Geography 15 ECTS credits (KG7216), Project on Assignment in Urban and Regional 15 ECTS credits (KG7217).

Misc

This course is eligible in the Master's programme in Urban and Regional Planning.
