Course content

The course is aimed at international students and researchers at Stockholm University who need basic Swedish to communicate with Swedish-speakers during their stay in Sweden. The course provides knowledge about the basic grammatical structure of Swedish through the learning of everyday Swedish words and phrases.

Learning outcomes

In order to pass the course, students are expected to be able to:

- use some common, everyday Swedish words and simple, everyday phrases in the correct forms and through adapting to the context
- apply the rules of Swedish word order in declarative sentences and questions, through asking and answering questions about day-to-day topics

Education

Instruction is given in the form of lectures. Students will practice practical language proficiency through webbased materials.

Forms of examination

- a. The course is examined through a digital examination consisting of several compulsory quizzes.
- b. Grades will be set according to a two-point scale:

U= Fail G= Pass

- c. Students will be informed of the written grading criteria when the course starts.
- d. In order to pass the course, students must receive an overall Pass grade on the digital examination, i.e. all compulsory quizzes.
- e. Students who receive the Fail grade on the digital examination are entitled to retake the compulsory quizzes during the next period in order to obtain an overall Pass grade. The examination is given at least twice per semester. Students who receive the Fail grade twice by the same examiner are entitled to have another examiner appointed for the next examination, unless there are special reasons to the contrary. Such requests should be made to the Department Board.

Interim

When the syllabus is discontinued or significantly altered, students have the right to be examined according to this syllabus once per semester during a transition period of three semesters. However, restrictions noted under e. above apply. For correspondences with earlier course systems, please contact the director of studies/student counsellor.

Limitations

This course may not be included in a degree at Stockholm University, either as a main field of study or as additional studies.
