Course content

The course will introduce students to the field of cultural policy and management. Students will acquire knowledge on finances, administration, governance and communication in theatre. The course will treat issues such as funding, public relations, audience development and theatre and the public sphere.

Learning outcomes

After the course students will have acquired skills:

- to critically analyze and evaluate cultural policy in the field of theatre
- to lead and take part in discussion on cultural policy and to identify the potentials and limits of its application in society
- to develop and reflect their own research position in the field of cultural policy
- to argue for own alternative concepts and ethical aspects of cultural policy

Education

Teaching will take place in form of seminars, lectures and group exercises. Teaching is in English, it is obligatory.

Forms of examination

Examination is in the form of written home assignments.

a) Grades are set according to a seven-point grading scale:

A=Excellent
B=Very Good
C=Good

D=Satisfactory
E=Adequate
Fx=Inadequate
F=Totally Inadequate

- b)The grading criteria for the course will be distributed at the beginning of the course.
- c)In order to pass the entire course, a minimum of grade E is required at every stage as well the submission of written assignments.
- d)In the event of a fail, a student who has received the grade Fx or F on a test has the right to take an additional four tests to attain the grade of E, as long as the course is still offered.

Students who receive a grade of E or higher may not retake the examination to attain a higher grade.

Students who receive the grade Fx or F twice from the same examiner are entitled to have another examiner appointed to determine the grade on the examination, unless there are any specific reasons against it. Such requests should be addressed to the department board.

Interim

When the course is no longer offered or the course content has changed significantly, students are entitled to be examined according to this course syllabus once a term for a three-term period. However, the limitations under "Forms of examination" above still apply.
